Statement from NEC Chairperson and National Returning Officer on the results of the Presidential election run-off held on 31st March, 2018

- 1. In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 33 and 38(8) of the Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1991 (Act No. 6 of 1991), and section 70(1) of the Public Elections Act, 2012 (Act No. 4 of 2012), the National Electoral Commission successfully conducted a Presidential election run-off in Sierra Leone on 31st March, 2018, pursuant to section 42(2)(e)(f) of the Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1991.
- 2. Both the polls and tallying processes were observed by political parties' agents, various national and international observation missions/groups, embassies and the media.

3. The Results:

- 11,122 polling station results were entered into the result database, representing 100% of all polling stations across the country.
- The national turnout is 2,578, 271 (representing **81.11%** of all registered voters).
- The total number of valid votes cast is 2,546,577 (representing 98.76 % of all votes cast).
- The total number of invalid votes cast is 31,694 (representing 1.24% of all votes cast).

- 4. The number of valid votes cast for each candidate is as follows:
- Kamara, Samura Matthew Wilson, All Peoples Congress, received 1,227,171 votes (representing 48.19% of the valid votes cast)
- Bio, Julius Maada, Sierra Leone Peoples Party, received 1,319,406 votes (representing 51.81 valid votes cast %)
- 5. Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on me as National Returning Officer by sections 52(2) and 94(4) of the Public Elections Act, 2012 (Act No 4 of 2012), I hereby certify that **Bio Julius Maada** having polled 1,319,406 of the valid votes cast in the 31st March, 2018 Presidential election run-off has been duly elected President of the Republic of Sierra Leone.
- 6. Any citizen of Sierra Leone who has lawfully voted in this election may challenge the validity of the said election of the President by petition to the Supreme Court of Sierra Leone, within seven days after the declaration of Presidential result pursuant to section 55(1) of the Public Elections Act, 2012 (Act No. 4 of 2012).
